**How to Become
a Part of the FBC Family**

By Transfer of Membership - If you are already a member of another Southern Baptist Church, we will receive your request for membership, pending receipt of a letter from that church. We will contact that church to notify them of your decision and request your letter.

By Statement of Faith - If you have previously received Christ as your Lord and Savior and have been baptized as a believer, by immersion as a symbol of your salvation, we will be happy to receive your request for membership. If you are a believer, but have not yet been baptized, we will set up a date for your baptism.
